DISCUSSION	 Provost Opp reviewed the Physical Master Plan slideshow that was shown to the Aug. 24 Campus Advisory Council. Three different campus concepts were presented. Library Dean Michele Van Hoeck would prefer to keep the Library close to the classrooms and academic buildings in the center of campus. If we want to continue holding formation with all students, we need to have a larger Quad or move formation to Bodner Field. Everyone agreed we should relocate parking away from the campus center. Some thought that we should plan for more faculty office space than is currently anticipated. All three of these concepts assume no additional land acquisition. No one liked the idea of having Administration far away from center campus up by Sonoma Blvd. We want to preserve open space at waterfront, not block it with high rise buildings Can we build on the Mini Park site?
