DISCUSSION	 Registrar's office is working through commencement lists to verify graduating seniors. Students must apply for their degree, and separately apply to participate in Commencement.

DISCUSSION	 Students graduating this spring and summer are eligible for Highest GPA award, to be announced at Commencement. Each student can get only one award. Academic department awards will be given at April 11 formation. Students will march into Commencement by major, and each major will carry a banner.

DISCUSSION	 NSSE results were presented March 8 to PC and SALT. Steve Kreta intends to share the results with students. Survey results show that students aren't aware that they are being taught critical thinking, although we have a Critical Thinking class. How do we fix this? Next NSSE survey will be administered in Spring 2017.
