DISCUSSION	<ul> <li>Academic Calendar Task Force discussed retention rates of sailing Seniors vs. sailing Sophomores – how many Freshman can we admit?</li> <li>Freshman for Fall of 2017 - not more than 69 MT, 10 FET, 41 MET, 50 ME</li> <li>Reduction of 33 Freshman</li> <li>Other Strategy: Can FET's do Cruise &amp; Internship at the same time? (Has been done in the past)</li> <li>Fallout of a smaller class – not as flexible in hiring Faculty</li> <li>Texas – can they sail w/ another Maritime Academy?</li> <li>MARAD may say the TSGB MUST serve other Maritime Academies</li> <li>Increase numbers in GSMA/IBL – if possible</li> </ul>
