An emergency Curriculum Committee meeting was held before the start of the semester to discuss the course, NSC 100 Naval Science for the Merchant Marine Officer, which was scheduled to be taught for the Marine Transportation and the Mechanical Engineering students during Fall 2013. LT Chad Mickelson proposed that NSC 100 be removed from the list of required classes for license-track majors. He still planned to teach a section of the course for the Strategic Sealift Officer Program students but couldn't find a reason why other students were required to take it other than it was a carryover from when all students were in a MMR type program.

After some discussion, the Marine Transportation Department informed the Committee that they want their students to take the course and that they would hire an instructor to teach two sections. The Mechanical Engineering Department decided to remove the course from the ME curriculum.

LT Mickelson will bring a CCR to the Curriculum Committee during the fall semester to address the removal of the course for the Marine Engineering Technology students who are scheduled to take the course during the spring semester.
