### **I. Approval of Minutes from the Last Meeting**

- \* Draft minutes from Thursday, November 7, 2013 are attached.

### **II. New Business**

- \* **CCR 02/14-01 NSC 310 Naval Operations** – Re-number course to NSC 320 so that NSC 315 Navigation (for engineers) will become a prerequisite for the newly numbered NSC 320 Naval Operations. Informal CCR is included to change course number NSC 310L Naval Operations Lab to NSC 320L.
- \* **CCR 02/14-02 MTH 210 Calculus I** – Replace MTH 100 Algebra/Trig requirement with MTH 210 Calculus I for MT students.
- \* **CCR 02/14-03 MTH 100 College Algebra & Trigonometry** – Remove MTH 100 from the ET curriculum. Freshmen ET students will be required to take MTH 100 prior to enrollment at Cal Maritime and will start their freshman year ready to take MTH 210 Calculus I.
- \* **CCR 02/14-04 ELEC 22 Humanities Elective (Upper Division)** – For the MET and FET majors, drop ELEC 22 Humanities Elective (Upper Division) requirement and substitute HUM 310 Engineering Ethics to meet the CSU General Education – Breadth requirements.
- \* **CCR 02/14-05 CRU 200S** – Remove the sea-day count from CRU 200 which expedites CRU 200 grades for enrollment in courses that have CRU 200 as a prerequisite.
