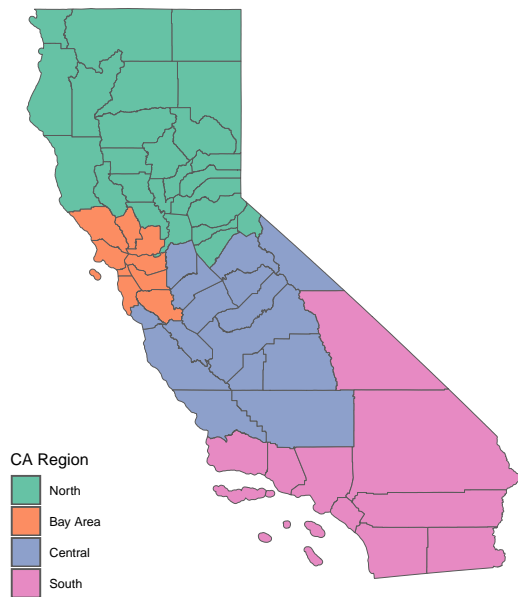

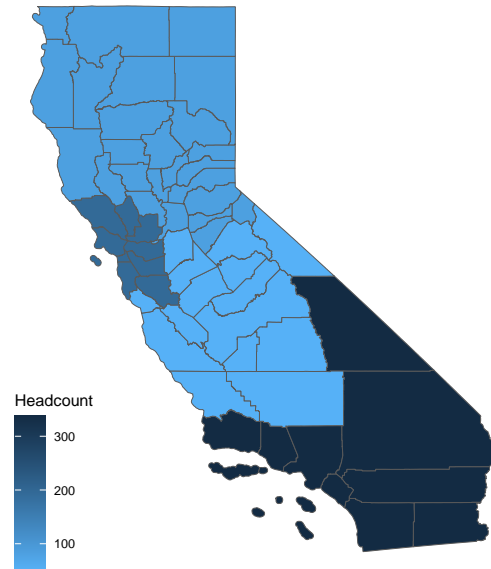

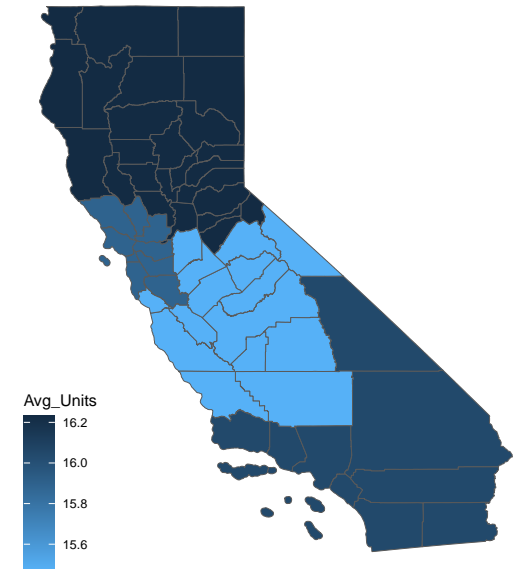
Table 6: Headcount, FTES, and Average Unit Load by California Region

- The following abbreviations for major are used in this report: BA = Business Administration, FET = Facilities Engineering Technology, GSMA = Global Studies and Maritime Affairs, ME = Mechanical Engineering, MET = Marine Engineering Technology, MT = Marine Transportation, OCN = Oceanography,
- Oceanography program enrolled initial cohort in Fall 2020
- Binary gender categories per CSU systemwide classification algorithm used to mitigate small cell counts
- Race/Ethnicity categories defined by Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS)
- California regions as used in the report describe the following counties:

- “Admit Type” refers to the path a student matriculated through. With few exceptions, all enrolled students started as either new freshmen or transfers
- Student Level is determined by the major curriculum: BA = 120 Units, FET = 154, GSMA = 120 Units, ME = 179 Units, MET = 159 Units, MT = 159 Units, OCN = 120 Units.
- Academic Level = “SSen” indicates “Super-Senior,” which is defined as having earned 115% of the major’s total units
