

UNIFORMS


Required Uniforms


- Khaki coveralls/khaki uniform

- Salt & pepper uniform

Grooming Standards

- Any exceptions to policy must be approved through the Office of Cadet Leadership and Development (CLD)
- Uniform & grooming standards are required as PPE for shipboard activity









PACKING LIST

- Packing list will be posted under SST webpage "Information for Cadets"

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Nothing goes down the toilet that is not bodily fluids or provided toilet paper
- One hand for you, one hand for the ship. You are on a moving platform
- Exterior ladders and stairwells can be very slippery – go slow and be careful

- Do not let doors slam. If you open it close it gently! She is an old ship!
- Please be courteous of noise watch standers sleep all hours of the day.



ANNOUNCEMENTS / EMERGENCY

- CELL PHONES
- No Cell Phones use while at work, during class or on watch.
- If you are using to snap a picture, snap and close.
- ➤ If you are on your off time and using, stand to the side and do not walk blindly while scrolling. This is dangerous on a moving vessel.

• EAR BUDS

- No Ear Buds use while at work, during class or on watch.
- Ear Buds cannot be used with or in place of PPE
- Off time use You need to hear EMERGENCY & Public Announcements (PA)
- Caution using Sound Canceling
